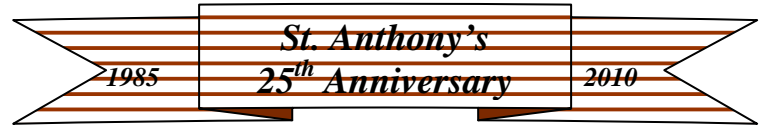

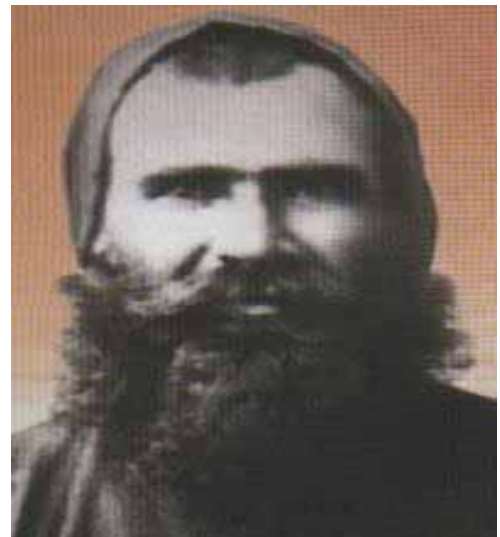

Sts. Peters and Paul, June 29th

There is sound evidence that both Sts. Peter and Paul preached in the city of Rome and were martyred there under the Emperor Nero about the year 64. Simon, a fisherman on the Sea of Galilee, was one of the first whom Jesus called to follow him. A natural spokesman for other disciples, Peter called Jesus "The Christ, the Son of the Living God." Peter began to preach about Jesus Christ to the crowds in Jerusalem and Samaria and later made his way to Rome where he died. Tradition says he died crucified head down, since he considered himself unworthy to die as his Lord had done. Saul of Tarsus was a Zealous Jew, a Pharisee who after dramatic conversion on the way to the city of Damascus, became a fervent apostle of Jesus. After a three years Period in Arabia, where he assimilated his new faith, Paul journeyed to the cities of Damascus, Jerusalem and Antioch. Because of his activity he suffered constant harassment from his enemies, enduring shipwreck, imprisonment and beatings. He was greatly loved by those Christians to whom he ministered: Corinthians, Ephesians, Galatians and Romans. To them St. Paul wrote his letters of consolation and instruction which the Church still reads today as inspired by God himself. After imprisonment in Rome, he was beheaded along the Ossian Way where his burial place is still venerated.

تأملات الأسبوع

- الاثنين 28 حزيران: خلال الصعوبات في حياتنا، لا نرى وجه الله، بل نتخبط ونشعر باننا وحدنا. فنحن نحتاج إلى بعض الوقت لكي نعرف أن يد الرب هي التي عملت فينا من خلال البشر. متى نكتشف يده الحانية علينا مثل يد أمهاتنا؟

- الثلاثاء 29 حزيران: ما نأكله لا ينجسنا. ما ينجسنا هو ما يخرج من داخلنا من نوايا شريرة، من غضب وكراهة وحقد يجعل حاجزاً بيننا وبين إخوتنا. ثم متى كانت طهارة الأطعمة أفضل من طهارة الأعمال؟

- الأربعاء 30 حزيران: نظرت المرأة الكنعانية إلى يسوع. أمامه سجدت وأعلنت إيمانها. هي ابنة إبراهيم بإيمانها، لا بطقس من الطقوس. ومن أجل إيمانها أجرى يسوع المعجزة وشفى ابنها. كيف يصبح يسوع ضعيفاً أمام مثل هذا الإيمان! هذه المرأة تفوقت بإيمانها على أولئك الذين يرافقون يسوع في حله وترحاله.

- الخميس 1 تموز: هل نقبل أن نخرج من أفكارنا المسبقة لننتفتح على ما أبعد ما تعودنا عليه؟ هكذا كانوا يعملون، وهكذا أنا أعمل. لا أريد أن أغترب في شيء. والجديد الذي حمله يسوع أتريده أن يبقى قديماً؟ أتريده أن يبقى حرفاً فلا يصل إليه الروح؟ هذا يعني أن نهتدي إلى الرب كل يوم، ونواصل المسيرة معه إلى حيث هو يريد.

- الجمعة 2 تموز: كلمة الخلاص. هذه الكلمة هي شخص يسوع الذي جاء ليخلص البشرية. هل نحن مستعدون للتعرف إليه، أم نحسبه معلماً مثل سائر المعلمين المتجولين؟ فيسوع هذا ما اكتفى بأن تكلم، بل بذل حياته، وصلب، وقام. أخطأ الشعب اليهودي حين أسلمه إلى الأمم. ولكن في العمق لم يدفع يسوع إلى الموت دفعاً، بل دخل في مشروع الله: هو يقدم حياته وهو يستعيدنا. قدمها في الموت واستعادها في القيامة.

ليضمن السيد المسيح نجاح رسالته، دعا رُسُلَهُ الإثني عشر ليكونوا شهود عيانٍ مقرّبين إليه، وسلّمهم سلطانه بالذات الذي أخذه من الآب، مزوداً إيّاهم بمحبّته وتشجيعه، مؤيداً إيّاهم بالروح القدس. إيمان بولس بالمسيح القائم بجسده حيّاً بالروح القدس، استقاه من نظرتة إلى الكنيسة جسداً للمسيح باكورة العالم الجديد، الذي ينتمي إليه المسيحيون كلّهم بأجسادهم بواسطة المعمودية والإفخارستيا، فيصبحون له أعضاء متّحدين بجسده السريّ. الرُّسُلُ الإثني عشر رُسُلُ البشارة، ومساعدوهم في تأسيس مختلف الكنائس والأنبياء والمبشّرون والواعظون الملهمون، في العهدين القديم والجديد، يُكتملون معاً بمواهب الفهم وتعليم الإيمان المسيحيّ العادي والرسمي في كلّ كنيسة. أرسل يسوع رُسُلَهُ للتبشير والتعليم في العالم قانلاً: "ها أنا أرسلكم..." وأنذرهم بالإضطهاد، من قِبَل الملوك والولاة الوثنيين، وأمنّ لهم العون والمساعدة بالروح القدس الخامي والمؤيد والمُشجّع والمُعزّي والمُعَلِّم. فيسوع في إنجيل اليوم يدعو الجميع إلى وعي سرِّ ملكوته ليسمعوا تعليمه ويلتزموا به، بما أنّ الخلاص بدأ باليهود وعمّ العالم، فرسالة يسوع هنا مثال لرسالة تلاميذه بعد موته وقيامته.

Gospel: Matthew 10: 16 -25

Reading: Corinthians 12: 12- 13, 27 – 30

To guarantee the success of his mission, Jesus called the twelve disciples to be close witnesses to his deeds. He gave them the same authority he received from the Father, lavishing on them his love and encouragement through the Holy Spirit. St. Paul's faith in Jesus the Risen Lord comes from his knowledge that the Church is the Body of Christ to which belongs all Christians through the Baptism. The twelve disciples are messengers of the Good News with those who helped them in broadening the Church of Christ. Jesus sent them to preach and teach in the world saying: "I am sending you..." He warned them about being persecuted by kings and pagan governors. He provided help for them through the Holy Spirit, the Advocate and the Teacher. Jesus invites everyone to understand the mystery of his kingdom, to listen to his teachings and live by them.
